



Lesson 16 – Possessive Adjectives

Target sentences:

Tá mé i mo chónaí ar an Srath Bán. I live in Strabane (*Literally I am in my state of living in Strabane*).

Mo My Aspirate (add 'h' to the noun)
Tá mé **i mo chónaí** ar an Srath Bán (*I live in Strabane*)

Do Your Tá tú **i do chónaí** i Muileann an tSiáin (*You live in Sion Mills*)

A His Tá sé **ina chónaí** in Ard Mhacha (*I live in Armagh*)

A Her = Does not aspirate e.g. Tá sí **ina cónaí** sa Ghléib (See lives in the Glebe).

Ár Our Eclipse e.g. Tá muid **inár gcónaí** i dTír Eoghain. (Tyrone)

Bhur Your (Plural) Eclipse e.g. Tá sibh **in bhur gcónaí** i mBéal Feirste. (Belfast)

A Their Eclipse e.g. Tá siad **ina gcónaí** i Léim an Mhadaidh.
(Limavady)

Cá bhfuil tú i **do chónaí?** Where do you live?

Mo mhathar My Mother (h after the first vowel of the noun).

Mo hathar My Father (h before the vowel).

Phrase of the week:

Ná habair smid! Say nothing/Mum's the word!
