### Target sentences:

- A) Cé thusa? Who are you?  
B) Is mise Antaine / Mise Antaine. I am / I'm Antaine.
- A) Cad é an t-ainm atá ort? What is your name? (Ulster dialect)  
B) \_\_\_\_\_ an t-ainm atá orm. My name is \_\_\_\_\_.

notes: *ort* = on you, *orm* = on me.

- A) Cad is ainm duit? What is your name? (Non-Ulster dialect)  
B) \_\_\_\_\_ is ainm dom(h). My name is \_\_\_\_\_.

- A) Cá as tú? / Cár b as thú? Where are you from?  
B) Is as an Srath Bán mé. Cá as tú fein? I am from Strabane. Where are you from yourself?  
A) 'As an Muileann an tSiáin mé. I'm from Sion Mills (More casual).

### Other examples:

- 'As Éireann mé. I'm from Ireland.  
'As an Fhrainc mé (the 'Fh' is silent). I'm from France.  
'As Sasana mé. I'm from England.  
'As na Stáit Aontaithe mé. I'm from the United States (of America).
