Object Pronouns

mé	<i>me</i>
thú	<i>you</i>
é	<i>him/it</i>
í	<i>her</i>
muid/sinn	<i>us</i>
sibh	<i>you</i>
iad	<i>them</i>

1. To hear - *Cluin*

Q) Ar chuala tú é?

Did you hear it?

+) Chuala mé dé Sathairn é.

I heard it on Saturday.

-) Níor chuala mé é.

I didn't hear it.

2. To see - *Feic*

Q) An bhfaca tú an scannán?

Did you see the film?

+) Chonaic é.

I saw it.

-) Ní fhaca é.

I didn't see it.
