

Lesson 23 - To get & to do

To get:

Stem and order/command form of the verb is 'Faigh'.

Question form: An bhfuair tú? = Did you get?

Positive answer: Fuair mé = I got.

Negative answer: Ní bhfuair mé = I did not get.

Q) An bhfuair tú *litir* ar maidin?

Did you get a **letter** this morning?

A+) Fuair. or Fuair, fuair mé litir ar maidin. Yes. Yes, I got a letter this morning..

A-) Ní bhfuair. or Ní bhfuair, ni bhfuair mé litir ar maidin.

No. No, I didn't get a letter this morning.

Order or Command form: Faigh litir ón Dochtúir.

Get a letter from the Doctor.

Ná faigh!

Do not get!

To do/ make:

Stem and order/command form of verb is 'Déan'.

Question form: An ndearna tú? = Did you do or make?

Positive answer: Rinne mé. = I did or I made.

Negative answer: Ní dhearna mé. = I did not do or make.

Q) An ndearna tú cupán tae/caife?

Did you make a cup of tea/coffee?

A+) Rinne. Or Rinne, rinne mé cupán deas tae.

Yes. Yes, I made a nice cup of tea.

A-) Ní dhearna. Or Ní dhearna mé tae nó coffee.

No. I didn't make tea nor coffee.

Order or Command form:

Déan cupán tae/coffee dom(h)!Make a cup of tea/coffee for me!
